This year 11 men received graduation certificates for completing the 9-month in-house Recovery Program where they have made many accomplishments and amazing transformations. This intensive program houses up to 24 men at any given time, and is free of charge.

Participants are provided Christian based classes, counseling, mentorship, chapel service, meals, medical assistance, transportation, work routine, and all other daily needs. The goal of the program is to become a saved spiritual man, and to help him get back on his feet.

Running from God my whole life kept me from going to church and knowing who He really is. I made drugs, food, relationships, TV, working, and money the gods of my life, leaving me empty and never satisfied. I tried to fill my life with these idols more and more, but it was never enough. My life continued this way for years, which caused emotional torment and strain on my family and relationships.

December, 2013, I was getting kicked out of the house. I was physically and emotionally spent, and did not want to fight for another month's rent and food. In a moment of clarity, I asked Jesus if He was real and to take my hand. Two weeks later I called the Mission to see if a bed was available in the Recovery Program, and by God's grace I enrolled.

Growing in the knowledge of His Word and prayer, I started my relationship with Jesus; and the first week of January, I was saved. I am learning who God is, how great His love is for all of us, and how to live as a Christian.

Attending church, becoming a member, and getting baptized has helped me to build healthy relationships and to become accountable. I pray and talk to the Lord every day, looking for His guidance and direction for my life. I now have a great job as a truck driver.

I would like to thank everyone for being a part of my recovery, my family, and God for never giving up on me even when I had. All thanks and glory to God and His Son, Jesus Christ!
